

CYO Financial Scholarship Guidelines

CYO scholarship applications will be accepted from any student 5 – 22 years of age. Scholarships are allocated as funds permit, and are based on the following criteria:

1. Completed Registration Form
2. Completed Scholarship Form
3. Copy of most recently submitted Federal Tax Form (must be from parents if student is claimed as a dependent on parent's income taxes)
4. Adjusted Gross Income less than \$30,000 may be awarded a full tuition scholarship, based on the availability of scholarship funds.
5. Adjusted Gross Income between \$30,000 up to \$59,999 may be awarded a half tuition scholarship, based on the availability of scholarship funds.
6. Adjusted Gross Income of \$60,000 and greater will receive no financial aid.
7. Requests for financial aid due to extenuating circumstances and do not meet the above criteria will be evaluated on a case by case basis by the scholarship committee, subject to the availability of scholarship funds. Financial relief may be provided in the form of a full or partial scholarship, or may require subsequent repayment.
8. Any student who is delinquent due to an outstanding balance or who is not current with their scheduled payments is not eligible for scholarship assistance.
9. Students who are granted a partial scholarship may choose to pay the remainder of their tuition on a monthly basis by supplying CYO with a credit card to be debited each month.
10. Scholarship awards are for the CYO fiscal year when the student is applying for entire year and for a semester if the student applies once the second semester commences.
11. Each family of the student awarded a scholarship will be required to complete the volunteer form and volunteer throughout the year for CYO when requested.
12. Scholarships are subject to review by the scholarship committee at the end of each semester.
13. Every family is required to pay the annual membership fee.
14. CYO does not provide scholarships for summer workshop or Symphony retreat.
